



**Connecting the Logitech BCC950 ConferenceCam to a Computer

1	Utilize the Zoom client app to join a Zoom video conference.	Join conference.
2	From the Zoom toolbar, click on the “up arrow” next to the camera icon. Select the “BCC950 ConferenceCAM #2” as the camera to use.	Camera “up arrow” – choose “BCC950 ConferenceCAM #2” as the camera.
